

How to Access and Save Your AHT Digital Badge

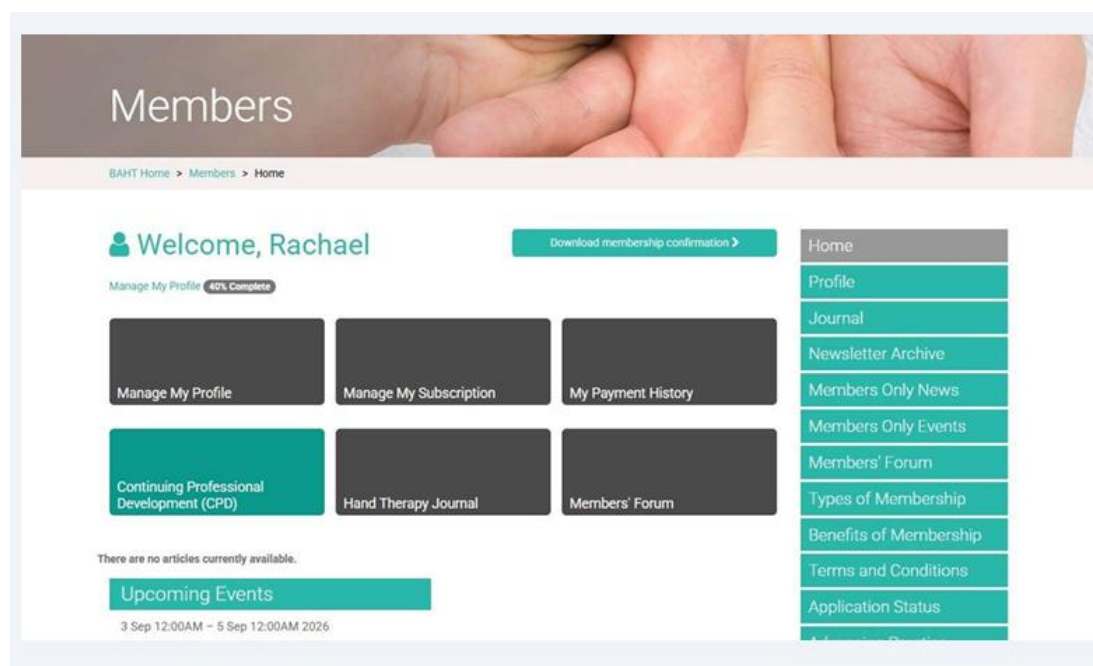
A guide for Accredited Hand Therapists (AHT)

This guide explains how members of the British Association of Hand Therapists (BAHT) who hold Accredited Hand Therapist (AHT) status can locate, view, and save their digital AHT badge from the BAHT member portal.

Step 1: Go to your Members dashboard

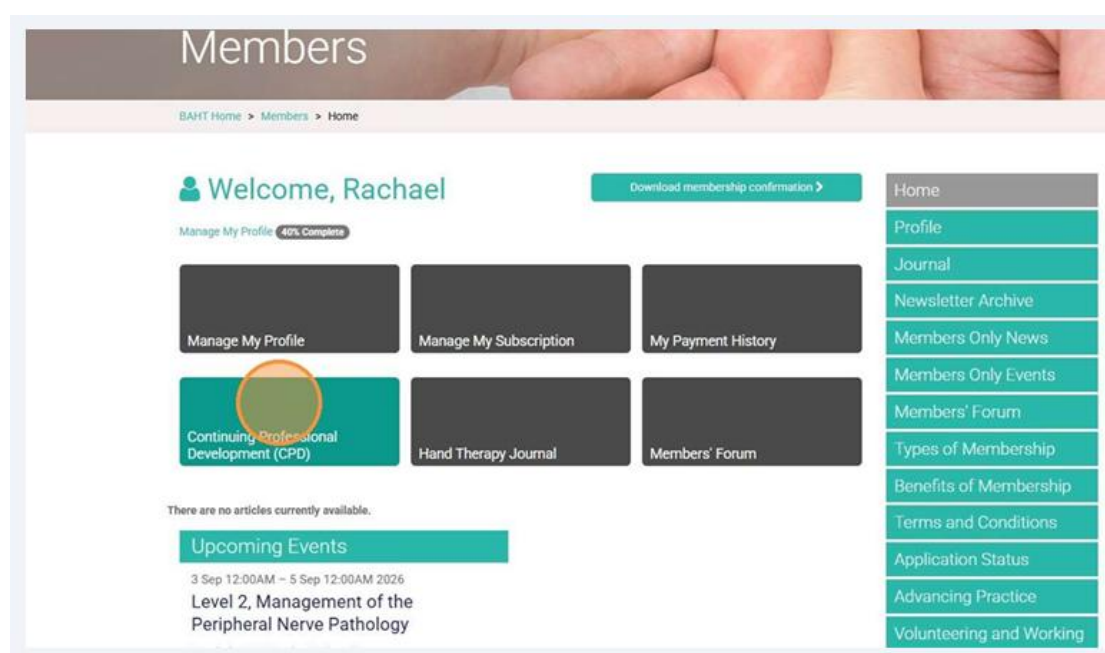
Log in to your BAHT account and navigate to your Members Home page.

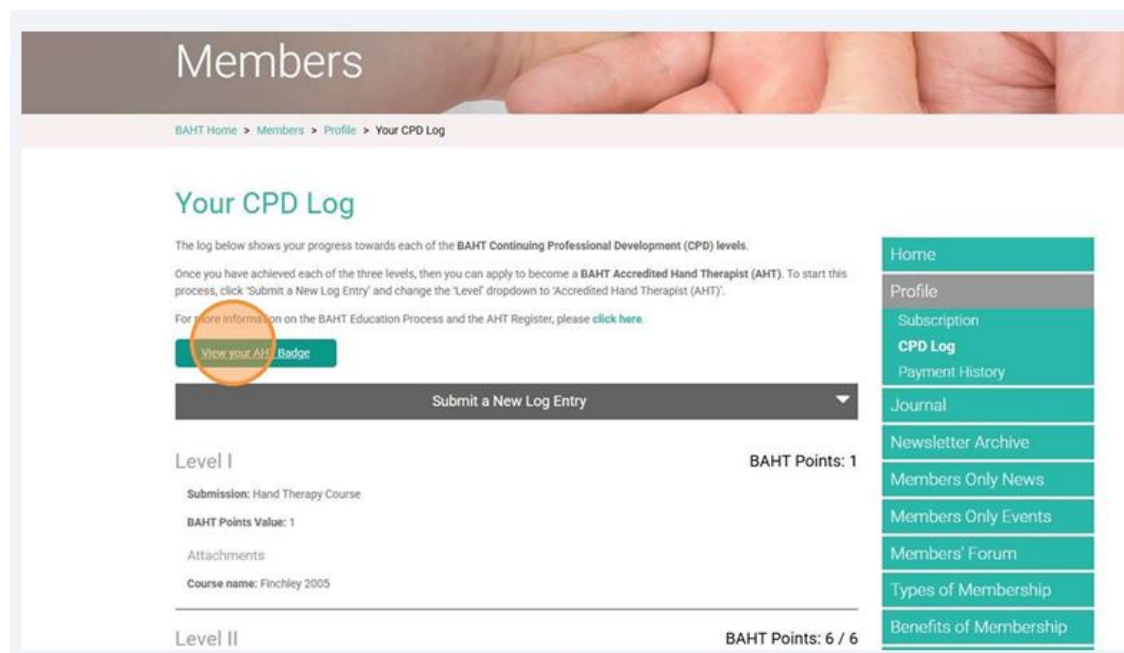
Step 2: Open your CPD section

From the Members Home dashboard, click "Continuing Professional Development (CPD)" to access the CPD section of your member account.



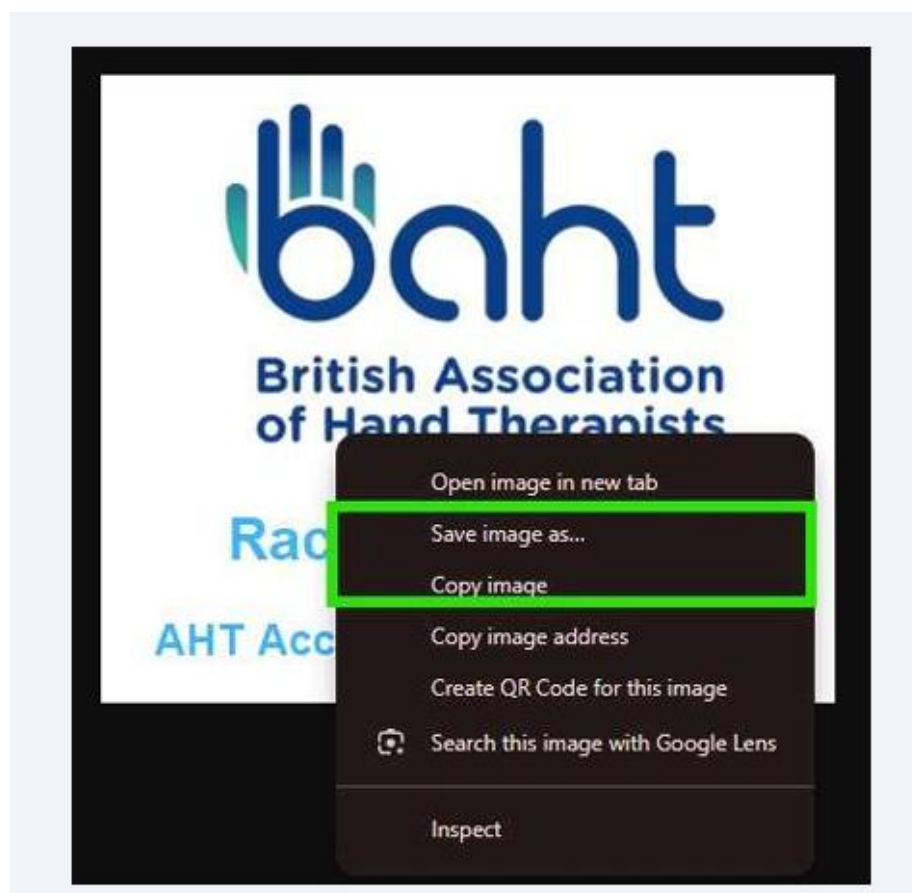
Step 3: View your AHT badge

If your account has been granted Accredited Hand Therapist status, a "View Your AHT Badge" button will appear at the top of your CPD Log. Click this button to open your badge.



Step 4: Save your badge

Your badge will appear on screen. Right-click the image and select "Save image as..." to save it to your device, or "Copy image" to paste it directly into another document or email.



Guideline for Using Your Digital Badge

Your AHT digital badge is a mark of current accreditation and should only be displayed while your accreditation remains valid. Please observe the following:

- The badge may be used on email signatures, professional profiles, websites, CVs, and promotional or clinical materials while your AHT accreditation is active and up to date.
- It is the individual member's responsibility to remove the badge promptly from all emails, websites, social media, and printed or digital materials if their AHT accreditation lapses, expires, or is withdrawn.
- The badge must not be altered, resized in a way that distorts it, or combined with other logos or wording that could misrepresent BAHT or the AHT scheme.
- The badge must not be shared with, or used by, any individual who does not personally hold current AHT accreditation.
- If accreditation is renewed after a lapse, a new or updated badge should be re-downloaded from the member portal rather than reusing an old, saved copy.
- BAHT reserves the right to request removal of the badge from any material where it is being used incorrectly or where accreditation is not current.

If you are unsure whether your accreditation is current, please check your CPD Log in the member portal or contact the BAHT Education Sub-Committee before continuing to display your badge.
