Criteria for Nathalie Barr Award Winners

A nominee should be considered to have significantly contributed to the field of hand therapy via the following means:

- 1. Should have had at least 10 years experience in hand therapy working at senior level
- 2. Should be considered an expert in the field of hand therapy
- 3. Should have some publishing experience as an author/co-author in a paper in a relevant hand therapy/surgery journal or book
- 4. Should have served time on a BAHT or EFSHT/IFSHT committee or sub-committee
- 5. Should have experience of presenting on at least 5 occasions to a hand therapy/surgery audience
- 6. Should have evidence of teaching on relevant hand therapy study days or courses
- 7. Should have demonstrable experience in audit and research
- 8. Should be comparable to the standard of previous NB award winners
