

Paediatric Hand Therapy

- Course fees:
 - £400 direct self-pay (personal BACS transfer)
 - £440 employer funded (invoice to employer)
 - 10% discount on all fees for BAHT members.
- This course is designed for Occupational Therapists and Physiotherapists with two years experience in Hand Therapy or who've completed a BAHT level I course, who wish to expand their knowledge and skills relating to the treatment of children with injuries/conditions affecting the upper limb.
- Physiotherapists and Occupational Therapists with at least two years experience paediatrics are also welcome to attend this course, but should be aware that the course builds on BAHT level I knowledge in particular in relation to the management of adult hand trauma.
- As with all BAHT Level II courses successful completion relies on passing the course examination (at the end of day 3) and assignment (to be submitted 6 weeks after the course). Pre-reading will be provided to all delegates to assist preparation.
- To reserve a place complete the registration form and return it via email to Debbie at hand-ed@outlook.com (place not fully secure until course fees paid in full).
- Cancellation policy: Refunds (less administration fee) may be offered for cancellations made more than 2 months prior to the course, at the organisers discretion. After this time refunds can only be offered if the cancelled place can be resold to another delegate. Substitutions can be made at any time up to one week prior to the course. Course fees will be refunded in full to all delegates should the course be cancelled by the organisers, but no liability is accepted for other monies paid out by delegates e.g. travel and accommodation costs.
